Request:

Since 1.9.17 please state how many times you are aware that a "parent" has been written to informing them they have had their licence to enter school premises withdrawn.

For the three most recent cases where this has occurred please provide me with an explanation, one sentence long, summarising what they had done to have the licence withdrawn. E.g.: Parent attacked and threatened teacher; parent was harassing classmates of their child, parent brought a knife onto school premises, etc.

Since 1.19.17 please state how many times criminal action has been taken against a "parent" under Section 547 of the Education Act 1996 for breaching an order banning them from a school.

Note: By parent I mean anybody who has parental responsibility for a child.
