- 6. Please provide me with details about any initiatives that have been launched to reduce male suicide over the last three years?

The North Tyneside suicide multi-agency action plan is based on a clear understanding of local needs and has a specific priority on reducing suicide risk in men, especially in middle age, as local suicide audits have demonstrated this is the population group most at risk. Initiatives include: Commissioned suicide awareness training for frontline staff specifically aimed at services that come into contact with men; Active North Tyneside have carried out suicide awareness raising initiatives targeting men, linked in with Newcastle United Foundation trust - 'be a game changer' brand; and Active North Tyneside have trained community sports coaches and leisure staff in Mental Health First Aid as they have a wide reach into local communities.

7. Please provide me with details about any initiatives that have been launched to reduce female suicide over the last three years?

North Tyneside suicide multi-agency action plan takes a Public Health population approach to suicide prevention through a range of actions. No initiatives have been launched to specifically reduce female suicides in the last 3 years.

8. Please provide me with details of events held by your council, in the last three years that promote positive male role models, fatherhood and marriage?

There have been no events held specifically to promote positive male role models, fatherhood or marriage.
