The Authority outsourced several its central "technical" services to Capita under a long-term contract that commenced on 01 November 2012. The arrangement will last until 2022 but may be extended to 2027. The parking enforcement function is undertaken by the Parking Control team, which is one of the services provided to the Council by Capita. As such this information is not held by the Authority.

2. What is the cost of traffic wardens - per year, over the last 5 years? (Last 5 financial years).
