In this Chapter "chief officer", in relation to a relevant authority, means each of the following— (a)the head of its paid service designated under section 4(1) of the Local Government and Housing Act 1989; (b)its monitoring officer designated under section 5(1) of that Act; (c)a statutory chief officer mentioned in section 2(6) of that Act; (d)a non-statutory chief officer mentioned in section 2(7) of that Act; (e)a deputy chief officer mentioned in section 2(8) of that Act.
