Please break this down by:

a. threatened with homelessness- prevention duty owed

175 households since 1st April 2020

 threatened with homelessness due to service of valid Section 21 Notice prevention Duty owed

Out of the 175, 24 were served valid notice

c. already homeless - relief duty owed.

151 households owed relief duty since 1st April 2020

How many local connection referrals where the council accepted a main duty were received in the same time period (April 1, 2020, to the most recent date)?

17 households received a final duty.
