Request:

I would like to know what formal courses Health Visitors would normally deliver regarding parenting skills for 4 to 5 year old's and what the names of those courses are.

Response:

Health Visitors do not currently deliver parenting skills courses for parents of children aged 4-5. However individual plans of care may be in place for children of this age, if a need is assessed. Health visiting teams use a range of resources to support families of preschool children.

Solihull is an evidence-based programme that is used to support families and parents can also subscribe to an online version free if they are a resident of North Tyneside. A programme of parenting courses is usually delivered from our Children's Centres, however currently these have been paused due to the Covid-19 pandemic.
