Request:

I would like to request some statistics on parking fines issued to residents parked in their residential zones because their permits had run out.

Please send me statistics for 2019, 2020 and statistics so far for the year 2021.

I would also like the statistics for how many paid the fines and how many contested the fines and the fines were voided.

I look forward to your reply.

Please make this a matter of urgency as I'm putting together my case for the independent adjudicators this month.

Response:

The information requested is not available.

**If a Civil Enforcement Officer observes a vehicle parked displaying an invalid permit, whether it is expired, for a different permit zone, etc. then they would generally issue a penalty charge notice under contravention code 12 (Parked in a residents' or shared use parking place or zone without either clearly displaying a valid permit or voucher or pay and display ticket issued for that place, or without payment of the parking charge) or contravention code 19 (Parked in a residents' or shared use parking place or zone either displaying an invalid permit or voucher or pay and display ticket, or after the expiry of paid for time).

These contravention codes cover a multitude of parking offences. Whilst we can provide information on the number of penalty charge notices issued for a specific contravention code in a specified time period, we cannot determine how many of these were issued to a resident for displaying an expired permit.**
