Request:

I am writing to make an open government request for all the information to which I am entitled under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. Regarding your organisation's current awarded or in procurement framework contracts relating to works in the Built Environment, including but not limited to professional services, design, consultancy/advisory services, construction and operation/maintenance, please send me:

- The value of each of these framework contracts;
- The set up date of each of these contracts;
- The projected duration of each these contracts;
- The financial limit of each of these contracts;
- Descriptive information for any services provided in connection to the Built Environment, Construction, Consultancy Services or Professional Services in any capacity;
- Details of any lots/sub lots of the contract;
- The names of the organisations currently appointed to the contracts.

Response:

This information is refused in answer to this request under section 21, information accessible to the applicant by other means.

To view only the Authority's Contracts register select North Tyneside Council from the Organisations list on the left of the screen under "Narrow Your Results" and press the Green Update button at the bottom of the same section.

To filter for the frameworks requested, under Categories press the cross next to Add UNSPSC Categories and from the pop up box under the Categories List use the radio buttons to select the following categories, then press the Select Categories Green button.

72000000 - Building and Facility Construction and Maintenance Services

80000000 - Management and Business Professionals and Administrative Services

The data can then be exported to Excel using the Green button underneath the Awarded Contracts section.
