2015/16 £1.597m
2016/17 £2.070m
2017/18 £4.690m
2018/19 £1.928m Budget

Flood Damage Repairs

The Council outsourced a number of its central “technical” services to Capita under a long term contract that commenced on 1st November 2012. The arrangement will last until 2022 but may be extended until 2027. As such this service is provided for the Council by Capita, which is a private company and as such is exempt from the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act. The information requested is not the Council’s information. In 15/16 the council received a grant from DEFRA to be spent on Flood Damage. In this year the spend was £31,216.43.
