Request:

Borough Road Footbridge demolition and diversion route costs

A figure of some £62k has been quoted for demolition of the Borough Road Footbridge and implementation of a permanent diversionary route crossing Borough Road between Waldo Street and Trinity Lane - leading to Addison Street. But I can find little detail of this.

Please provide a full costs breakdown for the actual total figure (information which will have been used to arrive at the total) itemising what works and procedural tasks (e.g. Public Rights of Way Order) are envisaged and the item cost for each. I want to know what works are going to be undertaken, whether these are the subject of the current planning application or not.

Response:

The 2016 Options Appraisal Report which references Net Present Value costs can be found under the Planning Application 18/01497/FUL/ Demolition of Borough Road Footbridge, North Shields Tyne And Wear.

The Council intends to install a controlled crossing on Borough Road to provide an alternative safe crossing point. This does not form part of the current planning application. The crossing has not yet been priced but the estimated cost is around £20k. No information is held on the future costs of diverting the right of way which will be developed if and when planning approval has been given.

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
