## Request:

Please can you tell me?

- 1. how many armed forces applicants are currently on the waiting list for council housing?
- 2. how long each armed forces applicant has been on the council house waiting list?
- 3. if the council prioritises armed forces applicants for council housing?
- 4. If the council doesn't have a waiting list, please can you tell me how long armed forces applicants have been on the choice-based lettings register?

## Response:

- 1. 4 applicants are currently active and have stated that they have either been employed in the forces or are currently employed and leaving within 6 months or have left the armed forces within 5 years.
- Applicant 1 09.02.2015
  Applicant 2 15.11.2014
  Applicant 3 29.09.2013
  Applicant 4 22.09.2015
- 3. For those in the Armed Forces, this applies where the applicant is either in the Armed Forces or has been a former member of Service Personnel and their application is made within 5 years of discharge; or the applicant is a bereaved spouse or civil partner of a deceased member of the Armed Forces and they are having to leave the Services' Family Accommodation following the death of their spouse or partner; or the applicant is a serving or former member of the Reserve Forces and needs to move because of a serious injury, medical condition or disability sustained as a result of being in the forces.

If the applicant is still in service, the Band 2 priority will be awarded 6 months prior to the date they are required to leave. This priority will also apply for those leaving of their own accord; however it will not apply to those that have been dishonourably discharged. The priority will only be awarded once.

4. The oldest application is from 2013.
