2014/2015 = 2 cancelled application, 50 Rehoused, 3 No duty.
2015/2016 = 2 cancelled application, 38 Rehoused, 8 No duty.
2016/2017 = 4 Cancelled application, 50 Rehoused, 7 No duty.
2017/2018 = 4 Cancelled application, 53 Rehoused, 10 No duty.
2018/2019 = 39 closed in prevention duty, 41 closed in Relief Duty, 9 Rehoused at Final Duty.
