Request:

I would be most grateful if you would provide me, under the Freedom of Information Act, details in respect to the contract below.

All Age Drug and Alcohol Treatment and Recovery Service

The details we require are:

* Suppliers who applied for inclusion on each framework/contract and were successful & not successful at the PQQ & ITT stages*

The Authority used the Open procedure for the new contract, which does not include a PQQ. There were 25 expressions of interest but only one tender was received from North Tyneside Recovery Partnership, comprising Northumberland, Tyne and Wear NHS Foundation Trust; Changing Lives; and Turning Point Services Ltd therefore, there were no unsuccessful suppliers.

* Contract values of each framework/contract (& any sub lots), year to date

The current contract is different to the one specified above, providing an integrated community drug and alcohol treatment and recovery service for adults only in North Tyneside. The spend to date in the 2018/19 financial year is £1,437,331 – this represents three quarterly payments of £479,110. Quarter 4 is outstanding but is expected to be for the same amount £479,110, making the total annual payment of £1,916,441.

* Start date & duration of framework

The new contract commences on 1 April 2019 for a period of two years.

* Is there an extension clause in the framework(s)/contract(s) and, if so, the duration of the extension?

There are two options to extend the contract, each for a period of twelve months.

* Has a decision been made yet on whether the framework(s)/contract(s) are being either extended or renewed?

No, the contract commences on 1 April 2019.
