- There are no specific housing policies. The North Tyneside Local Plan 2017 includes a range of policies supportive of all forms of housing development within the Borough. Support for a mix of range and type of homes and housing development is set out within Policy DM4.6, which includes support for self-build and reference to community schemes.
