## Request:

I am writing to you under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 to request the following information. Please may you provide me with:

\* The amount awarded to North Tyneside Council by the Children of Alcohol Dependent Parents Innovation Fund from 2018 - 2021.

£445,818

\* Number of alcohol related deaths or alcohol related harm in the area in 2017, 2018, 2019 and 2020.

North Tyneside's rate for:

- alcohol related mortality 53.9 per 100,000 (2018)
- alcohol specific mortality 14.9 per 100,000 (2017-19)

2020 data not available.

\* How much was spent on projects providing support to children of parents experiencing alcohol related issues during the financial year of 2019, 2020 and 2021 to date.

2019 / 20 - £262,991 2020 /21 - £182,827

\* What were the outcomes of the projects i.e. how many parents and children were offered ongoing or long term support, rate of relapse etc if possible.

71 adults positively engaged with our innovation programme and were supported to access alcohol treatment.

137 children and young people were identified as living in households with Alcohol Dependent Parents and were offered a range of intensive emotional and practical support.

\* What programmes are currently in place to support children of alcoholics now that funding has ceased.

We have mainstreamed our approach and continue to support children in a variety of ways through our Early Help Service, Young Carers programmes, PROPS and other voluntary sector partners.
