3. Do you issue any guidance to schools over what action to take if a present member of the teaching staff is convicted of abusing a child at their school? If so, please provide me with a copy of that guidance.
4. Do you issue any guidance to schools over what action to take if a past member of the teaching staff is convicted of abusing a child at their school? If so, please provide me with a copy of that guidance.
