i) in work - 4

ii) in further education - 0

iii) NEETs – 8 (1 x Unknown)

b) Please provide the total number of pupils who left secondary school in the 2012/13 academic year who have subsequently at some point attended:

iv) a prison - 0

v) a young offender institution - 3

If a pupil has attended both, please only list them for the first of the two institutions they attended so as not to duplicate the individual number who have attended a prison or YOI. Obviously in practice this means listing them as attending a YOI only.
