Request:

I would like to make a freedom of information request with the following questions?

Is North Tyneside Council responsible for maintaining the Ralph Gardener Monument on Chirton Green, North Shields?

Does North Tyneside Council have any records in its archives specifically relating to Ralph Gardener (who was alive during the seventeenth century)?

Response:

North Tyneside Council holds three specific titles relating to Ralph Gardner in its local studies section at North Shields Customer First Centre:

England's Grievance Discovered by Ralph Gardner Monopoly on the Tyne – papers relating to Ralph Gardner (published 1978) Ralph Gardner and the Tyne a chapter of Local History by Thomas Clarke (1881)

We do not hold any **records** on Ralph Gardner. Our team checked the Northumberland Records Office catalogue online, and it appears that they only hold the same publications as ourselves. However, Tyne & Wear Archives, based at the Discovery Museum in Newcastle has the following:
