I am looking to understand more about children being taken into care as a result of the family being homeless. I would be very grateful if you could please provide the following information. I request this information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

The number of incidents of children becoming looked after by the local authority in the financial year ending March 2018 because their family was in acute stress (according to the main category of need they were filed under), where the central reason for this acute stress categorisation was that the family became homeless.

In each incident:

1. The number of children who became looked after
2. The age of the children who became looked after

In the incident, whether the child/children become looked after as a result of:

- A) a care order
- B) voluntary agreement under S20 Children's Act 1989
