Request:

- Data relating to the number of PCN notifications issued between 1st January 2018 and 30th September 2018 in WB1, where the residents parking permit has expired by up to 7 days.
- 2. Data relating to how many of those PCN notifications referenced in point 1 were appealed and won that appeal
- 3. Data relating to how many of those PCN notifications referenced in point 1 were appealed and lost that appeal.
- 4. Data relating to point 2 and 3 detailing why the conclusions were drawn on appeal.
- 5. The assessment criteria that NTC Parking Control use to make those decisions.

Response:

Information not held, the software system does not contain a parameter by permit zone or by appeal reason cited. We would have to go through every street or back lane included within the permit zone and then through every penalty charge notice that was issued at these locations to identify the appeals reasons cited and the status of the case. Our permit spreadsheet also only contains data on current permits, so we could not determine from the software available whether the penalty charge notice had been issued within 7 days of the permit expiring – the expiry date of a permit is not routinely recorded by the Officer in their notes.
