## Request:

The request specifically applies to Class A, covering shops and other retail premises such as restaurants and bank branches.

- Q3. How much income was generated by applications under the Town and Country Planning (Use Classes) Order of 1987 to alter the usage of retail outlets in the following timeframes?

  - 2017

For clarification the information provided relates to changes within retail classes and from retail to sui generis but not changes from non-retail to retail. Information has been extracted from the Council's Uniform system based on the classification of applications by development type (ie. Major and minor retail and service; other and change of use).
