Request:

How many employees in the last 6 years have left and are entitled to a local government pension?

Pre 14/15 is not held as it was not recorded. The following numbers are Council staff who have left the Council or resigned from one role but may still be employed by the Council in another role and are in the LGPS scheme.

14/15 - 732

15/16 - 709

- 16/17 812
- 17/18 973

19/20 - To November 626

How many of those who left have had their records checked to see if they had received job evaluation payments from 2008 to date?

The payroll reports run for leavers show if an employee has received JE payment.

How many of those who have left have had their records checked for equal pay awards?

Records are not held of how many LGPS members who have left have received an equal pay award.

How many of the employees who had received a job evaluation payment have had the payment spread over the years the payment was relating to for pension purposes?

All JE payments are moved to the years they relate to.

How many of the employees who had received a equal pay payment have had the payment spread over the years the payment was relating to for pension purposes?

This information is not held separately or centrally. To provide the information would require examining each employee's record. First to determine if they were a leaver, then to identify if they had received an equal pay payment. Therefore this part of the request is refused under s12(1) Freedom of Information Act 2000, since the cost of complying would exceed the appropriate limit set out in the Freedom of Information and Data Protection (Appropriate Limit and Fees) Regulations 2004. 3852 individual records would need to be reviewed to identify the specific reasons around employees accessing their pensions and whether they were council or

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school staff. However, we can confirm all payments are moved to the years they relate to.

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
