## Request:

Could you please provide the following information under the Freedom of Information Act:

All reported enquiries regarding defects within the carriageway are recorded on our Symology system, however, the system does not allow us to separate which ones relate solely to potholes and which are for other issues such as requests for major surfacing works, therefore, we are unable to provide the figures for how many individual potholes were reported to highways. We can, however, identify how many reports we received for defects in the carriageway which resulted in an inspection.

1. The number of potholes reported within your local authority area in 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 (to date), broken down by year.
