

**Request:**

We are writing to request information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

These questions relate to the information which is collected on a monthly basis for the Unify2 Data Collection - Delayed Transfer of Care, NHS Organisations, England. We are interested in the statistics which count the Number of Patients with a Delayed Transfer of Care at midnight on the last Thursday of the reporting period, Acute and Non-Acute, for NHS Organisations in England by the responsible organisation.

- 1) For the month of March 2017, please tell us how many individuals in North Tyneside appear within the following Delayed Transfer of Care categories:

*Di) Awaiting residential home placements or availability*  
*Dii) Awaiting nursing home or placement or availability*  
*E) Awaiting care package in own home*  
*I) Housing*
