Arts Award Discover is about discovering the arts around you, taking part in arts activities, finding out about artists – like authors and illustrators – and sharing what you've done.

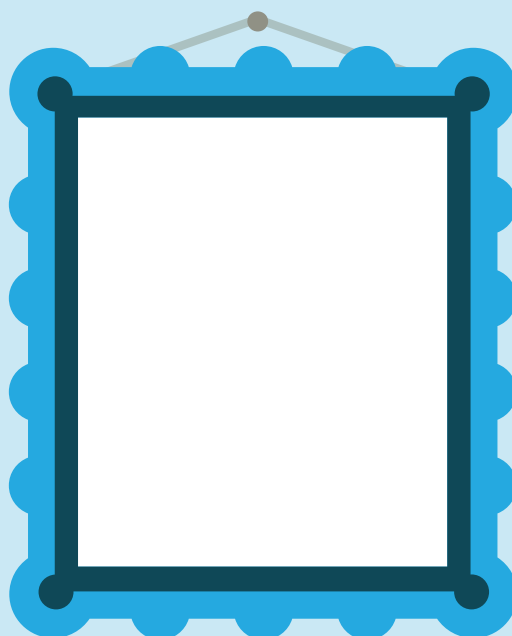

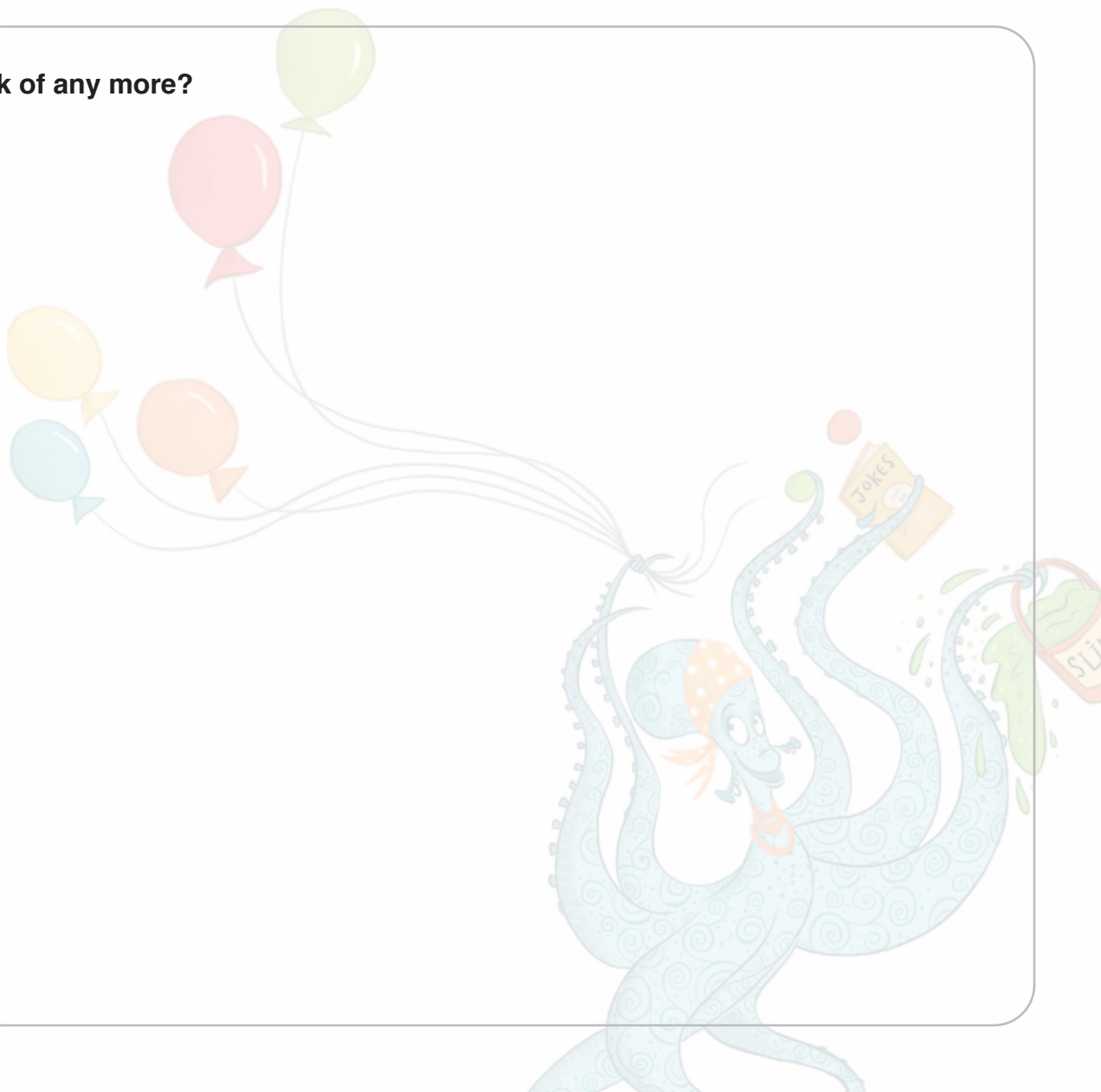

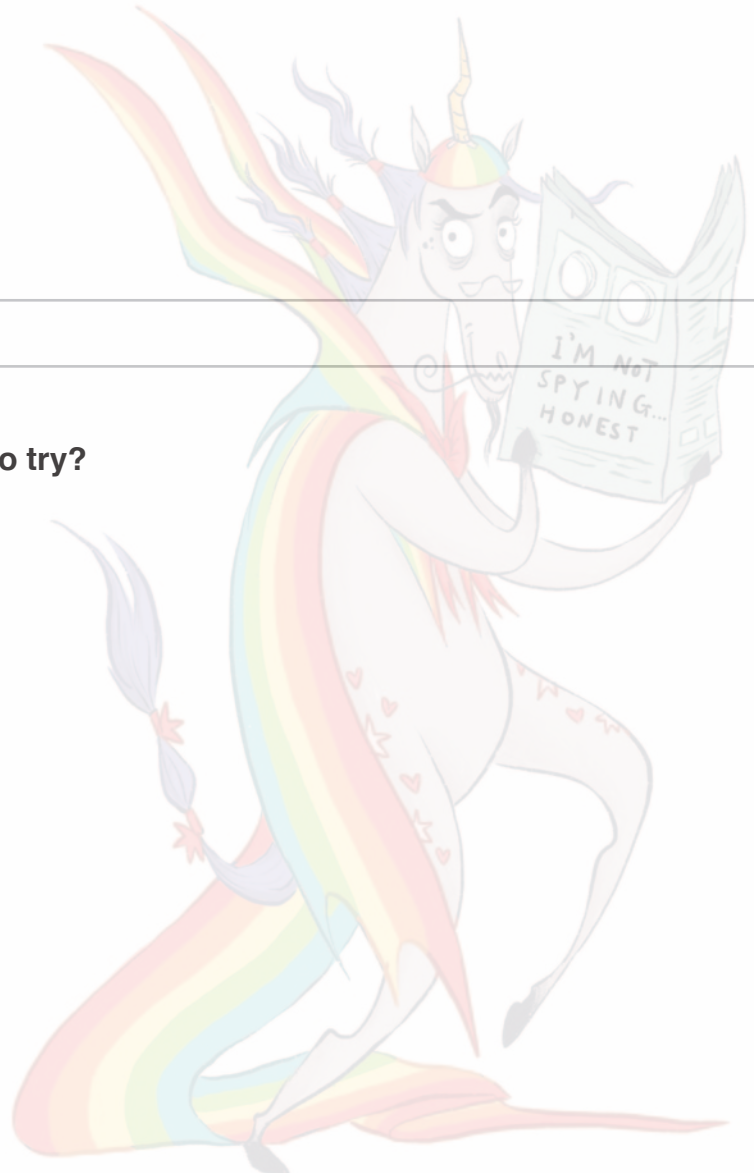

Who likes making music or singing?

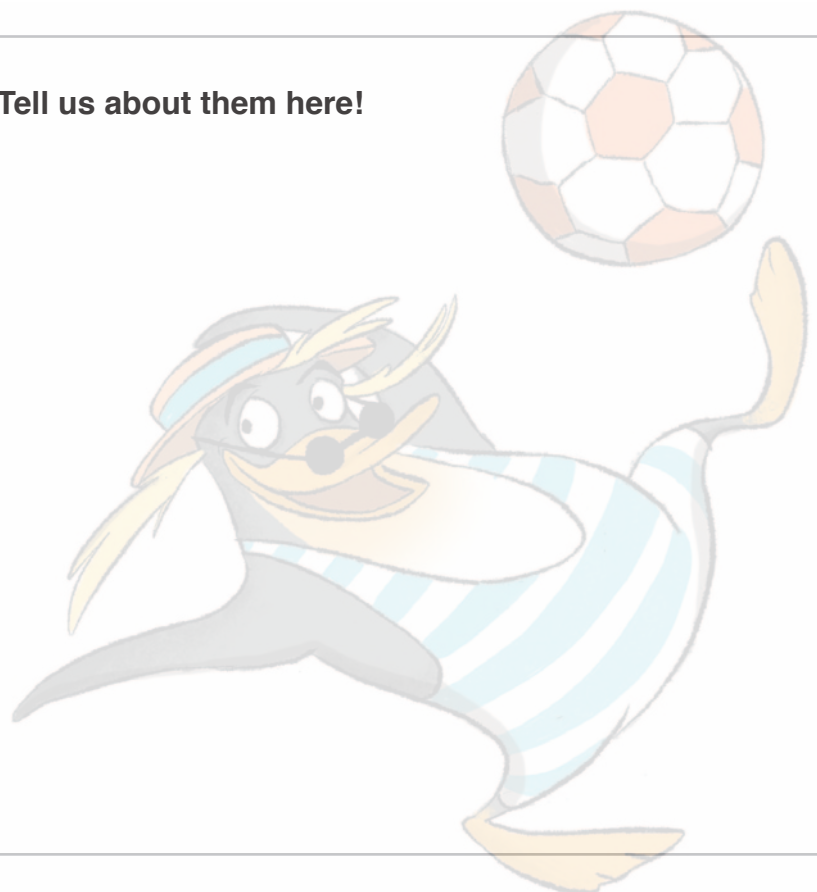

What is Arts Award?

Arts Award supports children and young people to develop as artists and arts leaders. It deepens engagement with arts and culture, develops both creative and leadership skills, and importantly, the Arts Award leads to a national qualification. Discover at Home is a special edition of Arts Award which celebrates children's creative achievements and is the first level of Arts Award. All children who complete Arts Award Discover will have their work assessed by a trained assessor and receive an Arts Award Certificate.
