5. Executive summary (taken from written report)

This Record of Decision relates to the approval given by the Cabinet Member for Environment to introduce a zebra crossing on West Bailey, Killingworth and to set aside one objection received to the proposal.

6. Alternative Options considered

Option 1 – Approve the recommendations set out in section 1.2 of the report and determine that a pedestrian crossing should be introduced in accordance with the proposal.

Option 2 – Not approve the recommendations set out in section 1.2 of the report and determine that a pedestrian crossing should not be introduced in accordance with the proposal.

7. Decision(s)

The Cabinet Member for Environment has considered the objection and has decided to:

- 1) set aside the objection in the interests of improving road safety for all road users and contributing to ensuring that highway conditions are conducive to support greater usage of cycling, walking and wheeling; and
- 2) determine that a pedestrian crossing should be introduced in accordance with the proposal.

8. Reasons for the Decision(s)

Regarding the objection from 'C', the Cabinet Member for Environment noted that the proposed crossing and associated bus stop relocation are expected to improve road safety for all road users. It was also noted that the change in traffic priorities at the western pinch point would benefit residents of Linden Park heading westbound when leaving their estate.
