Arrangements:				
•	Monkseaton High School will undertake all pupils' Annual Reviews of EHCPs (including EHCPs issued by another Authority) in December 2024. In line with paragraphs <u>9.166 – 9.176 SEND Code of Practice: 0 to 25 Years (2015)</u> , they will submit the paperwork to the Authority within two weeks of the Annual Review but have committed to sending them no later than the end of the Autumn term. Should Cabinet determine at the end of December 2024 that pupils in Year 9 will not progress on to Year 10 at Monkseaton High School, the Authority will, for those EHCPs it maintains, send statutory consultations to the child's nearest school and alternative schools in line with parental preference, by 2 January 2025. Schools consulted with will be required, in line with paragraph <u>9.83 SEND</u> <u>Code of Practice: 0 to 25 Years (2015)</u> , to respond to those statutory consultations no later than 16 January 2025.
