5. Executive summary (To be taken from written report)

This Record of Decision relates to the approval given by the Cabinet Member for Environment to introduce waiting restrictions which involve the marking of double yellow lines (no waiting at any time) and single yellow lines (no waiting Monday to Saturday between 8am and 6pm) at various locations in Wallsend Town Centre and to set aside one objection received to the proposal.

6. Alternative Options considered

Option 1 – Approve the recommendations set out in section 1.2 of the report and determine that the Traffic Regulation Order should be made unchanged.

Option 2 – Not approve the recommendations set out in section 1.2 of the report and determine that the Traffic Regulation Order should be made with modifications.

Option 3 – Not approve the recommendations set out in section 1.2 of the report and determine that the Traffic Regulation Order should not be made.

7. Decision(s)

The Cabinet Member for Environment has considered the objection and has decided to:

- 1) set aside the objection in the interests of discouraging obstructive parking thereby improving access, visibility and road safety for all road users; and
- 2) determine that the Traffic Regulation Order should be made unchanged.

8. Reasons for the Decision(s)

Regarding the objection from Mr W concerning the loss of on-street parking, the Cabinet Member for Environment noted that the proposed restrictions would be confined to locations where parking was causing an obstruction in order to facilitate access for all road users (including the Authority's refuse collection team) and to improve road safety.
