### 4. Executive summary (taken from written report)

On 12 July 2024 the Director of Regeneration and Economic Development authorised;

- (1) that notices for the proposal should be prepared and advertised in line with relevant statutory requirements; and
- (2) that if no representations are received following the period of consultation, a pedestrian crossing shall be established in accordance with the proposal.

The notices were prepared and advertised in accordance with the statutory requirements and no objections were received during the statutory advertising period.

Therefore, a zebra crossing will be installed on Denbigh Avenue, in accordance with section 1.5.1 and Appendix 1 of the Delegated Decision Report of 11 July 2024.

## 5. Alternative Options considered

### Option 1

To endorse the recommendation (3) as set out in paragraph 1.2 of the 11 July 2024 Delegated Decision Report that a zebra crossing should be installed on Denbigh Avenue in Wallsend.
