At the Cabinet meeting of 25 June 2018 delegated authority was granted to the Director of Public Health, in consultation with the Head of Health, Education, Care and Safeguarding, the Head of Commissioning and Asset Management, the Head of Resources, the Head of Law and Governance and the Cabinet Members for Adult Social Care, Public Health and Wellbeing, Finance and Resources to undertake a procurement exercise for a specialist drug and alcohol treatment service in North Tyneside to identify a provider(s) and to appoint the tenderer who submitted the most economically advantageous tender.

A Procurement Steering Group was set up to guide the process. This group consisted of North Tyneside Council officers, Representatives from North Tyneside Clinical Commissioning Group, Northumbria Police, National Probation Service and the Community Rehabilitation Company.

Following stakeholder consultation and a Provider Event, a service specification was developed

The procurement exercise was carried out in accordance with the Authority's Contract Standing Orders, the Public Contracts Regulations 2015 and EU procurement regulations and resulted in one compliant tender.

The compliant tender was fully evaluated and, subject to clarification, met the requirements set out in the service specification.
