Traffic Regulation Order – Waiting Restrictions, Mylord Crescent, Camperdown

4. Executive summary (To be taken from written report)

On 24 June 2025 the Director of Regeneration and Economic Development authorised

- (1) that notices for the proposal should be prepared and advertised in line with relevant statutory requirements; and
- (2) that, in the event that no objections were received following the period of consultation, that the circumstances do not warrant the holding of a Public Inquiry; and
- (3) that if no objections were received following the period of consultation required by statute, the Traffic Regulation Order shall be made.

The notices were prepared and advertised in accordance with the statutory requirements and no objections were received during the statutory advertising period.

Therefore, the circumstances do not warrant the holding of a Public Inquiry and the Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) should be made to make variations to restrictions on waiting and loading which involve the introduction of “no waiting at any time” restrictions on Mylord Crescent, Camperdown in accordance with section 1.5.2 and Appendix 1 of the Delegated Decision Report of the 24 June 2025.

5. Alternative Options considered

Option 1

To endorse recommendation (3) as set out in paragraph 1.2 of the 24 June 2025 Delegated Decision report – that the Traffic Regulation Order shall be made to make variations to restrictions on waiting and loading which involve the introduction of “no waiting at any time” restrictions on Mylord Crescent, Camperdown.

Option 2

Not to endorse recommendation (3) as set out in paragraph 1.2 of the 24 June 2025 Delegated Decision report – that the Traffic Regulation Order shall be made to make variations to restrictions on waiting and loading which involve the introduction of “no waiting at any time” restrictions on Mylord Crescent, Camperdown.

Option 1 was the recommended option.

- (1) To confirm that no objections were received during the statutory advertising period relating to the proposal;
- (2) That the circumstances do not warrant the holding of a Public Inquiry; and
- (3) That the Traffic Regulation Order shall be made for the introduction of waiting restrictions on Mylord Crescent, Camperdown in accordance with section 1.5.2 of the Delegated Decision Report of the 24 June 2025.
