On 26 September 2024 the Director of Regeneration and Economic Development authorised

- (1) that notices for the proposal should be prepared and advertised in line with relevant statutory requirements; and
- (2) that, in the event that no objections were received following the period of consultation, that the circumstances do not warrant the holding of a local inquiry; and
- (3) that if no objections were received following the period of consultation required by statute, the Traffic Regulation Order shall be made.

The notices were prepared and advertised in accordance with the statutory requirements and no objections were received during the statutory advertising period.

Therefore, the circumstances do not warrant the holding of a Public Inquiry and the Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) should be made to make variations to vehicle movements which involves the formalisation of existing no entry except cycles restrictions on Henley Gardens and Melrose Gardens.

5. Alternative Options considered

Option 1

To endorse recommendation (3) as set out in paragraph 1.2 of the 26 September 2024 Delegated Decision report – that the Traffic Regulation Order shall be made to make variations to vehicle movements which involves the formalisation of existing no entry except cycles restrictions on Henley Gardens and Melrose Gardens.

Option 2

Not to endorse recommendation (3) as set out in paragraph 1.2 of the 26 September 2024 Delegated Decision report – that the Traffic Regulation Order shall be made to make variations to vehicle movements which involves the formalisation of existing no entry except cycles restrictions on Henley Gardens and Melrose Gardens.

Option 1 was the recommended option.


