- More streamlined but time invested in joint agreement on key outcomes

To Additional Educational Needs Panel

Support planning meeting held; identification of outcomes

Proposed EHC plan written

Proposed plan delivered to parents

Plan finalised, shared & implemented

If no plan issued inform parents within 16 weeks of request for assessment – if no plan ensure parents are informed of where needs can be met from Local Offer
