The gardening service is aimed at helping our most vulnerable, disabled and elderly tenants. Due to their personal circumstances these groups may have more difficulty keeping their gardens tended.

To qualify for this scheme you must not have any able bodied person over the age of 18, who would be able to maintain the garden, living in your property.

The scheme runs from April to October, weather permitting.

If accepted onto the scheme you will receive two visits per year and we will cut your grass and hedges or bushes.
