There's something for every young reader.

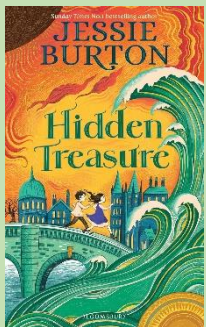

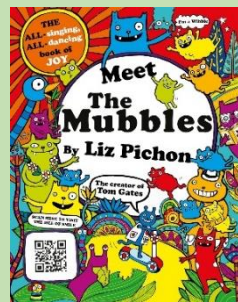
Kittyopolis is in chaos! Pancakes are turning monstrous and FLIPPING out.

Luckily, Max's pal Rex Rocket, Cosmic Weiner Dog, is here to help. But will their combined efforts be enough to clean up such a massive mess?!

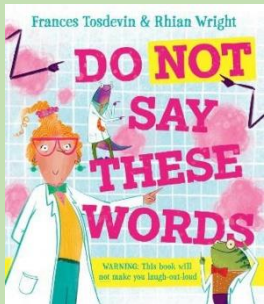


It's a dark and stormy night, and Sophie knows that there is a MONSTER hiding under her bed. So, like any sensible child, she decides to send him a letter.

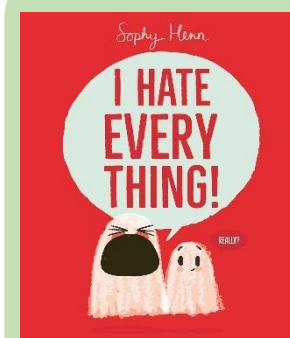
