

## **Changing our thinking.....Wash, Squash and Recycle**

### **Terms and Conditions**

#### **Residents**

Open to North Tyneside residents only. Only one pledge/entry permitted per person.

Pledges / competition entries can be submitted until 31<sup>st</sup> December 2018.

To be eligible for a spot prize, entrants must be aged 18 or over and have pledged to wash, squash and recycle. Monthly spot prize winners must be prepared to take part in post competition publicity and have their name and address area (e.g. North Shields, Killingworth, etc.) published on the council's website.

Entrants are required to provide their full name, full address, contact telephone number and email address (if applicable). North Tyneside Council would like to retain entrant's information after the competition closes to provide them with details of future environmental campaigns. Only the details of entrants that have ticked the box provided on the pledge form will be retained.

North Tyneside Council does not accept responsibility for any undelivered postal entries or for any disruption, delay or misdirection of postal entries.

In the event of any fault, mistake, misunderstanding or dispute concerning the correctness or acceptability of any answer given by entrants, or the operation of any part of the competition, the decision of North Tyneside Council shall be final.

#### **Monthly Spot prize**

The recipient of the spot prize will have their name and address area (e.g. North Shields, Killingworth, etc.) published on the council's website. There will be one monthly spot prize of £100 worth of shopping vouchers.

To be eligible for the £100 worth of shopping vouchers, an individual must have given their consent for their bin to be visited by the Reward Team.

If this consent has been given, they will be entered into a random draw to win the spot prize. If they are chosen at random and a member of the Reward Team finds their bin contains recyclable items that have been washed and squashed they will receive the spot prize. The individual will continue to be included in the draw until the competition closes or all spot prizes are issued.

#### **Schools**

Open to North Tyneside schools only.

Only one pledge/entry permitted per school.

All schools that have pledged to wash, squash and recycle will be automatically entered in to a prize draw. A winning entry will be selected at random every half term. The spot prize is £100 towards an environmental project of their choice.

The winning school will be contacted within two weeks of being chosen. For delivery of the prize, North Tyneside Council may ask representatives from the school to be available at a specified time and place.

However, North Tyneside Council reserves the right to change the prize due to circumstances beyond its control or if any part of the prize otherwise becomes unavailable, and/or to offer an alternative prize.

If for any reason the winning school chooses not to take up the prize or any part of the prize, the council reserves the right to ask the school to confirm this in writing and the council will be able to retain or dispose of the prize at its own discretion.

North Tyneside Council may refuse to provide the prize, or seek its recovery, in the event of non-entitlement under the terms and conditions or an entrant's fraud or dishonesty.
